Kimlau Memorial Arch Reconstruction

Updates:

- **Procurement** is complete and construction is starting imminently
- Construction duration is anticipated for 1 year (completion summer 2026).

TENTATIVE construction fence boundary




Scope of work

Proposed Work Key

Work shown is typical for all elevations

- 1. Disassemble arch lintel/column connections and lintel roof stones.
- 2. Remove cracked portions of granite and hold for re-use or for modeling new replacement
- New and/or refurbished structural steel assembly and connections
- 4. New matching granite components or reinstall salvaged building fabric wherever possible
- 5. Rout and replace failed mortar joints
- Chemically clean/wash entire structure
- 7. Footing/foundation stabilization as required
- Install new bird deterrent apparatus along roof ridge, column tops and projecting side
- Restore and chemically clean existing cast concrete benches

A PLACE TO **GATHER**

A green, shaded, and comfortable gathering place where mature trees, thoughtful amenities, and flexible spaces invite people of all ages to connect, rest, play, and celebrate together.

SAFE AND CONNECTED

A road design that improves pedestrian safety and neighborhood connectivity and that minimizes friction at key crossings to Kimlau Square.

CELEBRATE **AND SHARE CULTURE**

A space that respects and reflects the neighborhood's history and cultural context.

INCLUSIVE AND ADAPTABLE

An inclusive space that should be designed flexibly to accommodate many different types of programming, uses, and people.

Overview of Existing Conditions

Design & Landscaping

- Lack of trees
- Few places to sit and rest
- Insufficient lighting
- Busy and noisy intersections
- Environment not respectful for memorialization

Arts, Culture, & Programming

- A place people pass through, not gather
- Desire for public art
- Lack of programming that highlights local history and cultural identity
- Insufficient space for community activities

Circulation & Connectivity

- Unsafe for pedestrians
- Sidewalks are too small
- Long crosswalks with dangerous intersections
- Placement of bus stops and Citibikes
- Poor bike lane configuration
- Poor neighborhood connectivity
- Insufficient wayfinding

General Concerns

- Poor accessibility
- Few activities for children and senior
- Not integrated with the rest of the neighborhood
- Need for cleanliness and upkeep
- At time feels unsafe




